Emergency Fuel Cost Rate Adjustment

In the event of a failure of the Snettisham hydroelectric project or transmission lines extending for a period of ten days or longer, an emergency fuel adjustment may be included in the Cost of Power Adjustment rate, beginning 14 days after the emergency occurs and remaining in effect until energy is again available to the Juneau area from Snettisham and the monthly billing cycle has made a full revolution. The COPA rate shall be recalculated every 10 days until the balancing account has been reduced to less than \$50,000 and greater than (\$50,000).

For example, assume Snettisham energy is cut off March 10th, and is expected to be unavailable for several weeks. The COPA rate would be calculated as follows and be effective with billings beginning March 24th.

a.) Balance of COPA Account on February 23 rd	\$ xxx,xxx.	}	C

This rate shall supersede that set forth on tariff sheet 170 and will be effective for billings through April 23. Costs will be updated, and a new rate will be effective for billings beginning April 24th.
